Add two-factor authentication to KAZOO with Duo


Overview

The Duo Integration app connects KAZOO with Duo's two-factor login service to add two-factor authentication to your KAZOO logins. Multi-factor authentication strengthens access security by requiring multiple methods (aka factors) to verify identity.

With the Duo app, adding this extra security to your account is easy. It works in conjunction with the Authentication app, so you'll need both apps in order to set up two-factor authentication. In addition to adding multi-factor authentication, this integration provides insights into access attempts, which will inform you of malicious activity so you can stay ahead of the game.

With the Duo Integration app, you can:

- Connect KAZOO with Duo's two-factor login service by entering your Integration Key, Secret Key and API Hostname from your Duo.com application settings
- Add two-factor authentication to your KAZOO logins
- View logs of failed authentication attempts
